- 3) How many Steps and Sets are performed in the Job of Journey Work? Lead up, set and last step
- 4) What is the formation of the Glencar Reel? This is a dance three facing three. The dancers line up in two rows facing each other, the gentlemen on one side and the ladies on the other side. Partners face each other.
- How many movements are in the Glencar Reel? 5) There are 7 movements in the Glencar Reel?
- What's unusual about the Chain movement of the Glencar Reel? 6) Not all couples take hands at the start – only couple one
- What is the Sidestep Through movement of the Glencar Reel? 7) All dancers turn and sidestep to the right passing face to face with their partner, finishing with two 3's (4 bars), sidestep back to place, again finishing with two 3's and turning into original positions (4 bars).
- What type of dance is Lannigan's Ball and what tune is it danced to? 8) The Lannigan's Ball is a round dance for 4 couples danced to the tune of the same name.
- 9) How do you perform the Quarters Hook in Lannigan's Ball? The gentlemen link right arms with the lady on their left and with promenade step dance around (2 bars) and back to their own partner giving left arms, turn partner (2 bars) and return to the lady on left with right arm (2 bars), finishing with each gentleman facing the lady on their left.
- How does the Lead Around movement of the Lannigan's Ball differ from how it is normally performed? 10) It is only performed once anticlockwise finish turning into a circle (8 bars)
